The aim of this presentation is not to claim that there are only 50 types of Salah but rather to list 50 Salah one should be aware of. Salah, fasting, charity, Dhikr, recitation of Qur'an, Dua etc. are general acts of worship and should be done as much as one is able to do them. May Allah Ta'ala grant us guidance to the best of worship. Āmeen.

Amongst the 50 Salahs listed, there are Salah which are:

- The 5 daily Fardh Salah
- Emphasised Sunnah Rak'āt which accompany the Fardh
- Less emphasised Sunnah Rak'āt which accompany the Fardh
- Wājib (the Witr is Wājib in the Hanafi school of Fiqh)
- Optional Nawāfil/Mandub Rak'āt which accompany the Fardh
- Volunatry Tatawwu' Salah
- Salah which are specific to certain days; some of which are Wājib, some Sunnah, and some optional
- Salah which are performed during specific scenarios; some of which are Wājib, some Sunnah, and some optional
- Salah which are specifically performed in congregation Jamā'ah whilst others which are to be performed individually

The number of Rak'āt for most of the Salah has not been included, nor has their virtue, method of performance or related rulings. This is because this presentation is specifically designed for teachers and students should they wish for a visual aid while they explain each Salah with its rulings, specific to the school of Fiqh they follow.

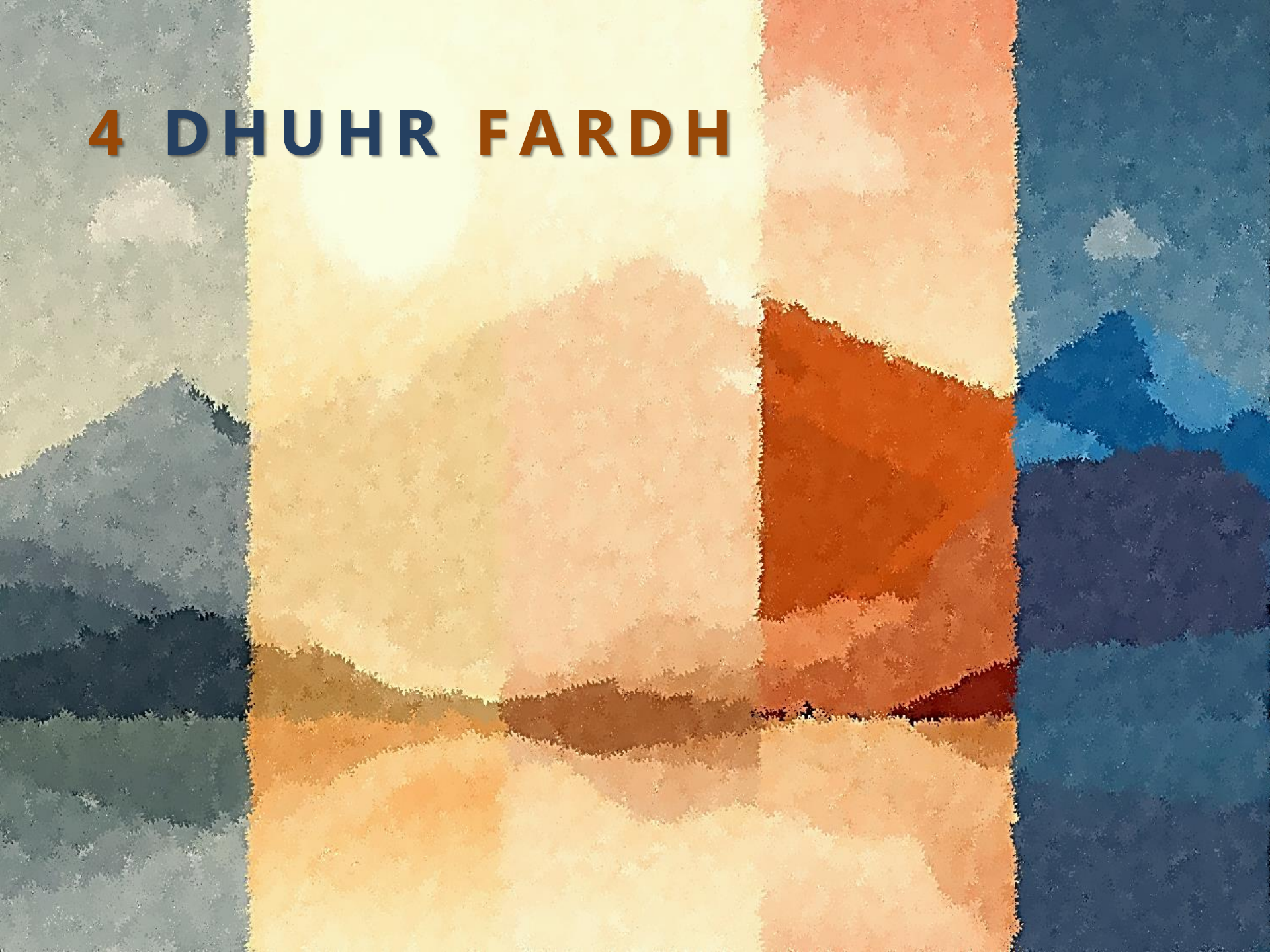
“O Muhammad!

Sahih Hadith narrated in Jāmi' at-Tirmidhi about the Isrā and Mi'rāj journey of Rasulullah (peace be upon him) where Allah Almighty honoured him with the gift of 5 daily Fardh Salah to be performed by his Ummah. The number was gradually reduced from 50 to 5. This honoured Rasulullah (peace be upon him) with more conversation with Allah Almighty and showed the mercy of Allah Almighty on this Ummah. The 5 daily Fardh are so great that if a person only performs these 5 well, they get the reward of performing a full 50 Salah daily. The more voluntary Salah a person performs, the more beloved they become to Allah Almighty.

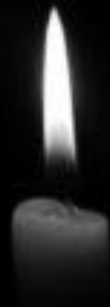

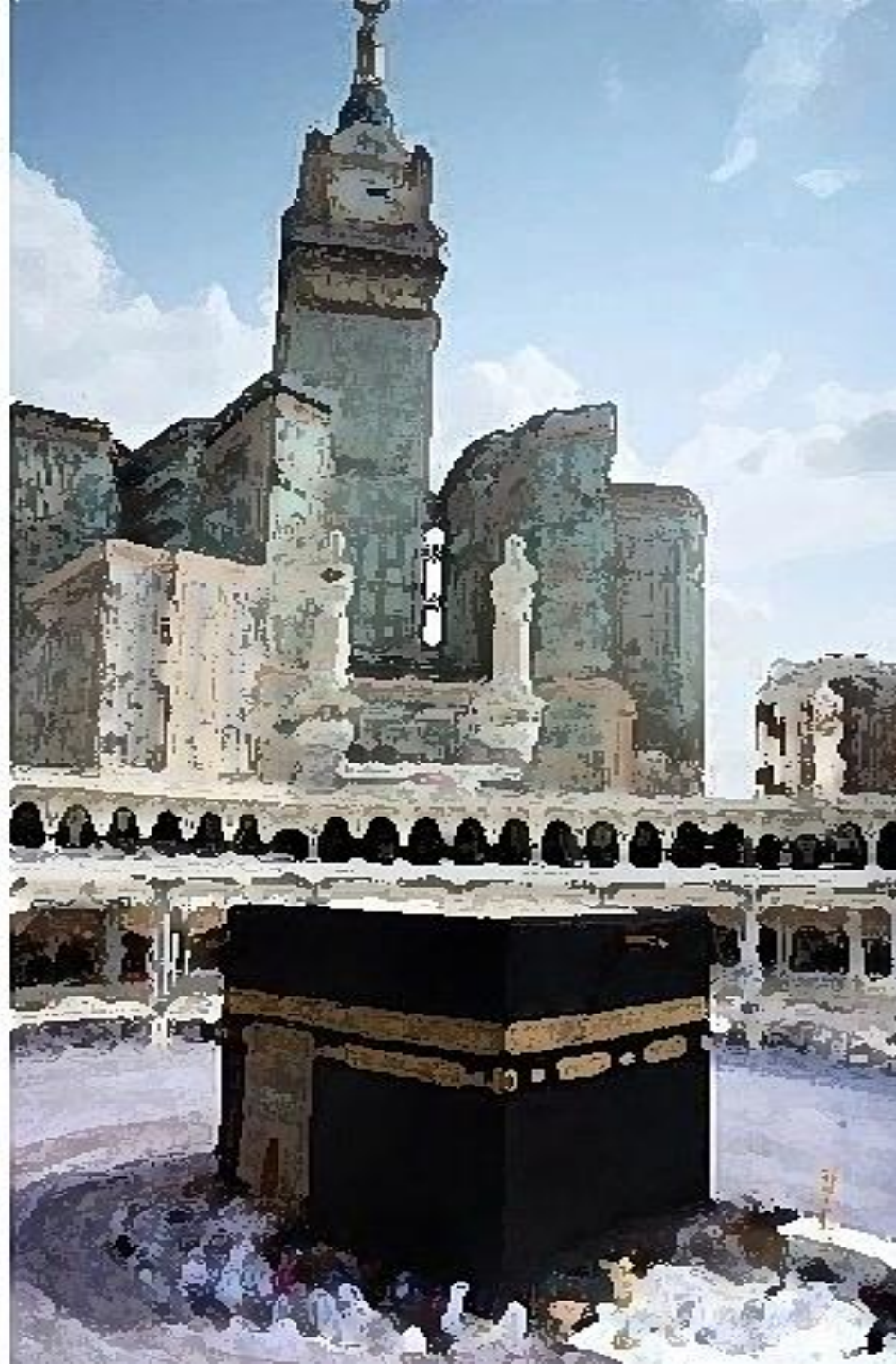

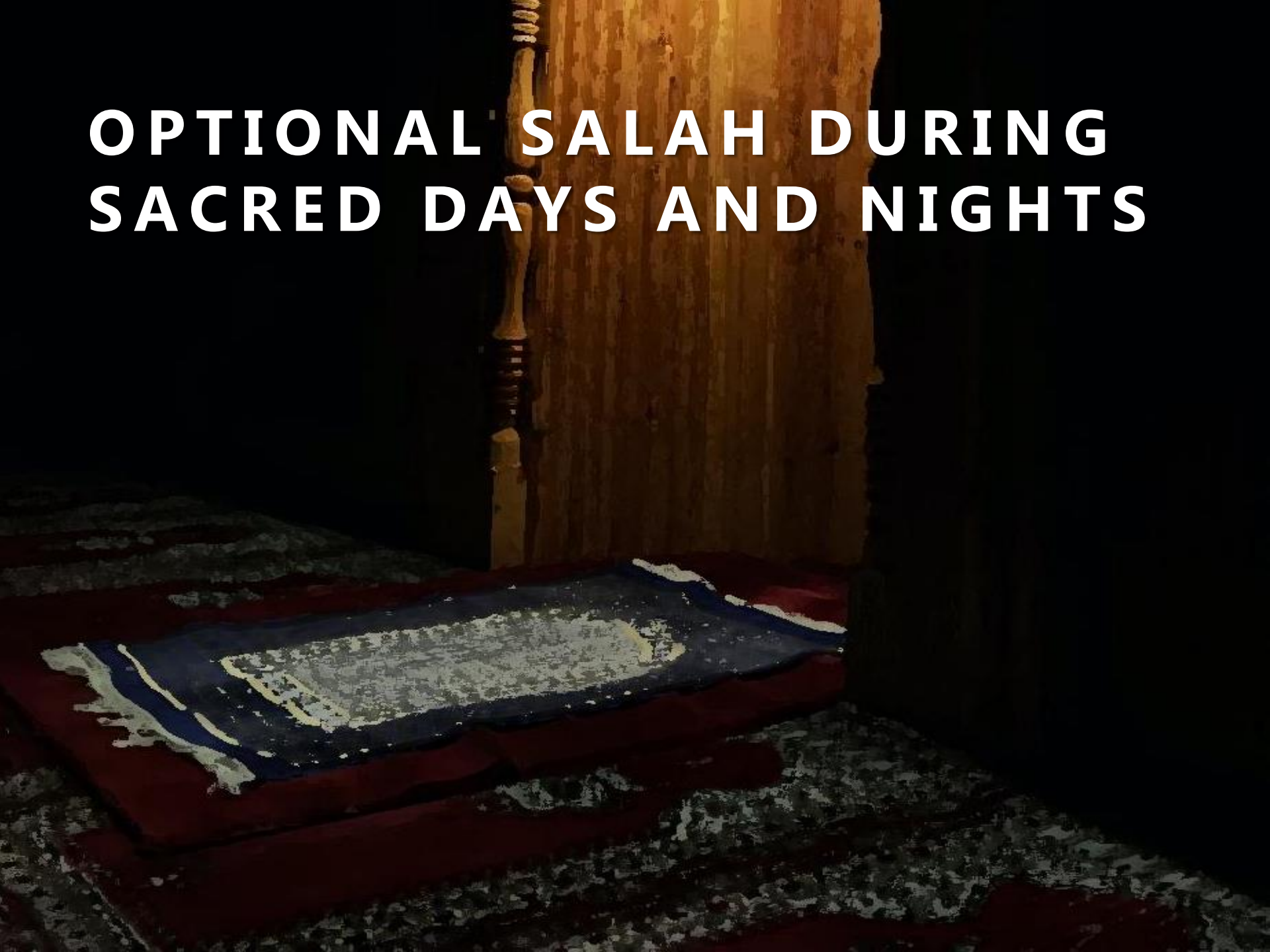
